Epidemiology




Logic Model: Short- and Long-term Outcomes






Logic Model: Short- and Long-term Outcomes






Example: Underage Drinking





Risk and Protective Factors

- Good stuff and bad stuff that encourages or discourages unhealthy behavior.
- RESEARCH BASED
- Some are shared between substance abuse and mental health

Risk and Protective Factors

- Classified in sectors (Individual, Family, Peer Group, and Society)
- Follow developmental stages
- For underage alcohol use, mostly present in middle school/adolescent stages
